- 1) You get the medication your doctor prescribed by making the co-payment outlined in your insurance plan.
- 2) You can get the medication your doctor prescribed but it requires higher co-pay or you have to pay a percentage of the medication's cost, called *co-insurance*.
- 3) You can receive a medication that has same benefits and is less expensive to you and your health insurer. It is a generic equivalent to what medication you were prescribed.
- 4) You can receive a medication that has similar benefits and is less expensive to you and your health insurer, but it is not a generic equivalent to what medication you were prescribed.
