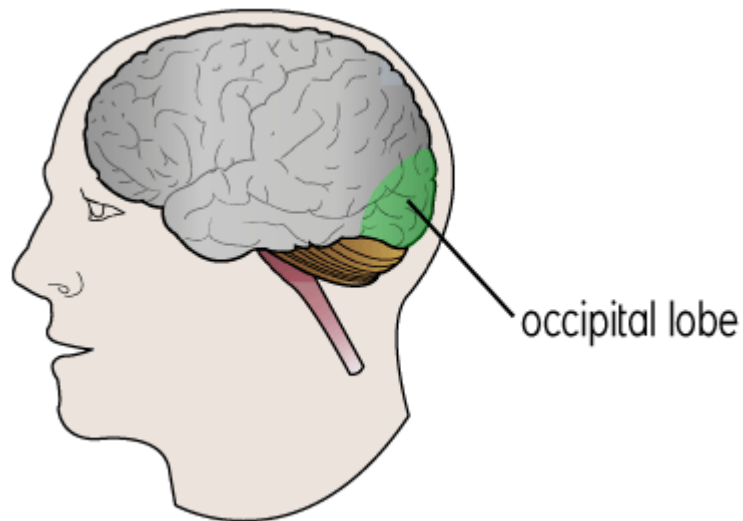


Occipital Lobe

The occipital lobe is in the back of the brain. Injuries to the occipital lobe may cause many symptoms related to vision.



The symptoms will depend on the extent and location of the injury.

The following symptoms may occur:

- Problems visually recognizing objects
- Difficulty reading or writing
- Poor depth perception
- Trouble grasping items
- Problems with how much can be seen in the field of vision
