



Reduce frequency of filling the prescriptions

Your insurance benefit may have coverage for a 90-day supply of medication.

You may ask your physician write your maintenance prescription for a 90-day supply. Not all medications will qualify for a 90-day supply.

You may also see cost savings by receiving medications of 90-day supply at a time.







Receive medication via mail

Mail order services work by having <u>your insurance company approve the service</u> and then your prescription medications are sent to your home. **No need to travel to a local pharmacy!**

Many local pharmacies have mail-order service. They provide free shipping. Check with your local pharmacy.
